Bilateral agreement on student exchange

Agreement on student exchange between the Faculty of Science, Chulalongkorn University (CU), Thailand and the Faculty of Science and Engineering, Linköping University (LiU), Sweden.

Preamble:

In order to FURTHER STRENGTHEN co-operation between the two universities we hereby agree to extend the Student Exchange programme for non-degree seeking students, as described below.

ARTICLE 1 Enrollment and duration of stay

Participating students (from LiU and CU) under the terms of this agreement shall be enrolled as non-degree students at the host university. The duration of the students' stay shall not exceed 12 months and not be below one semester.

ARTICLE 2 Tuition and academic fees

Students participating in this exchange shall be exempt from paying tuition and academic fees to the host institution; however they shall pay whatever fees are required of them by their home institution in order to participate in the programme. The tuition fee exemption shall be applied to only the regular programs in Faculty of Science, CU. The additional program fee may be required for the special and international programs in Faculty of Science, CU.

To be exempt from tuition fees students participating in this exchange program must be registered at the home university and will be studying a part of their education in the host university on a temporary basis as part of an official study abroad programme as an exchange student.

ARTICLE 3 Field of study

Students from CU are able to take all courses/do projects within the area of Engineering and Science (single subject courses as well as courses from all Master programmes at the Faculty of Science and Engineering). Students from LiU are able to do research/projects/take courses within the area of Science and Technology at the Faculty of Science with the consent of the corresponding programs.

ARTICLE 4 Number of students and level

Each year during the term of this agreement, the Faculty of Science, CU may send up to four bachelor/postgraduate students for one semester or two students for one year each of study to the Faculty of Science and Engineering, LiU. The Faculty of Science and Engineering, LiU may send up to four undergraduate/postgraduate students for one semester or two students for one year each of study to the Faculty of Science, CU. The number of students shall be agreed each year. It is understood that the number of students may differ each year but a balance in number of students exchanged shall be sought over a three-year period.

ARTICLE 5 Selection criteria

Participating students will be selected by their institution on the basis of the following criteria which shall generally apply but may be deviated from in appropriate cases. Thus, the students must:

- a. have a good academic record
- b. have adequate language proficiency to conduct studies at LiU
- c. meet all specific requirements set down by the home university and host university.

ARTICLE 6 Admission criteria and the host university's right of rejection

Participating students seeking admission to the host university under the terms of this agreement shall meet the admission requirements of the host university. Each university reserves the right to reject candidates, in which case further candidates may be proposed. The universities will provide each other with adequate information on the performance of participating students.

ARTICLE 7 Rules and privileges

Students participating under the terms of this agreement shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the host institution. They will have the rights and privileges enjoyed by other students at the host institution.

ARTICLE 8 Accommodation and insurance

Each university shall make every reasonable effort to assist students participating under the terms of this agreement in finding suitable accommodation. The payment of housing together with the payment for all travel, medical insurance and subsistence cost shall be the responsibility of the individual student participating in the student exchange programme and neither university shall be held liable for such charges. Students selected shall satisfy the home university that they have adequate funds for transportation to and from the home university and for subsistence during their stay.

ARTICLE 9 Activities for foreign students

Students participating under the terms of this exchange agreement shall be entitled to participate in any introductory courses or programmes that may customarily be arranged for foreign students at LiU.

ARTICLE 10 Record and credits

Each institution shall provide a record of subjects taken and grades received by each exchange student. Credit for subjects taken will be transferred at the discretion of the home university.

ARTICLE 11 Documents and certifications

Each exchange student is responsible for obtaining a visa and other related documents required for study at the host institution. The host institution shall provide incoming exchange students with any university certifications required to obtain a student visa for the full period of the exchange.

ARTICLE 12 Modification of agreement

This agreement may be modified by mutual written consent at any time.

ARTICLE 13 Duration, renewal and termination

This agreement shall take effect starting from the date of the last signature affixed to it and be valid for five years. Either university may, by notice in writing of no less than 6 months, terminate this agreement but students who have commenced their studies before the date of termination may complete their courses of study.
